

This year on January 20th, at night, our annual Tu BiShvat observance begins. In Israel the almond tree begins to blossom and spring arrives. We celebrate this renewal of nature by planting trees and eating the seven special



fruits of Israel. Among them is the date.

This fruit, which has an edible soft exterior, has a large hard pit. It represents the things that we start that seem easy at first, and then get difficult: our spiritual practices, our exercise regimens, our relationships. Often we begin well, with the best intentions and then hit a wall. It is hard to maintain the momentum of a good habit and sustain a positive change in our routine.

He will be reading every Shabbat except once per month when our own Stanley Bernsteen will be reading. Stanley is a perfect example of the talents and capabilities of many of our members. The weekday and holiday Torah readings will be by Rabbi Adler and our own members. Rabbi Polirer and I will be pleased if any congregant would like to chant one or more aliyot on any Shabbat.

Security Committee Mort Cooper

The story of Chanukah tells of the valor of the Maccabees who fought when their way of life and values were under attack. They persevered and emerged victorious and so will we.

The new Temple Security Committee was established in November and we are trying our best to keep our members and guests as safe as we can. On November 28th, a program on security was held at the Temple, which featured a presentation by the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office and a division of Homeland Security. About 250-300 people attended. On December 5th, a Town Hall program was held that had State Representative Emily Slosberg and State Senator Lori Berman, along with four other presenters talking about security. Approximately 225 people were in attendance.

We are working on evacuation plans for the Sanctuary, Social Hall and the Temple as a whole. CPR, AED and first-aid classes will be held. You may volunteer for these classes but be aware you have to get down on your hands and knees, do 100-120 compressions per minute and get back up. Leave your name in the office if interested. All alarm systems in the Temple are being tested, cameras inside the Temple will be checked to ensure they are working properly and additional cameras will be installed. Outside cameras will be installed. New motion detectors will be placed inside and outside. Surveys will be done to eliminate any dark areas outside and bollards (steel pipers filled with concrete) will be placed at all entrances. The items above are just the beginning. More security work waits to be done.

The Temple and the need for additional security was briefly mentioned in newscasts on channels 4, 12, and 5. We live in increasingly troubled times and the Committee is diligently working to eliminate or minimize any adverse actions that may be taken. Our guards have had military or police training.
