Presídent's Column Línda Cooper

Shalom,

It is an honor and privilege to have been elected as President of Temple Anshei Shalom for a second year. Thank you, Rabbi Adler, Cantor Beleniski, and the 2018 Officers and Board of Directors for your help and support to propel the Temple to even greater heights over the last year. I look forward to working with Rabbi Adler, Cantor Beleniski,



all the Past Presidents, and our new 2019 Officers and Board of Directors as we build upon our success and continue to strive for greatness in the future.

Speaking of building, as you know, each year thousands of people walk through the doors of Temple Anshei Shalom. Unfortunately, our nearly 40-year-old building is in need of significant updating and capital repairs. In Judaism, the number 40 represents a new generation and rebirth. In this week's Torah portion, Parshas Bo, Hashem afflicts Egypt with the final three plagues and the nation of Israel commences its exodus from Egypt and embarks upon a 40-year sojourn through the desert before they reach the land of Israel. Additionally, towards the end of the Torah portion, the mitzvah is given to tell over the story of the exodus from parent to child, thereby linking one generation to the next, which we do every year at the Passover seder.

In order to help give our building a rebirth so that it can serve the next generation, we are in the process of cultivating the first ever Temple Anshei Shalom Capital Campaign. We have retained a local consulting firm that specializes in working with religious institutions. The consultant will be conducting a feasibility study in the next few weeks to assess the best strategy for proceeding with our Capital Campaign. You will be hearing more about this in the weeks and months ahead.

To look after the fitness of the building, we have formed a Capital Campaign Committee as well as a Security Committee. The Security Committee is working closely with the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office to help ensure the safety of all our congregants and guests. The Committee is also working on evacuation plans for different sections of the building to ensure that people can evacuate quickly and safely under various situations.

Of course, we will continue all of our religious services, programs, classes, lectures, and activities that are enjoyed not only

Power Of Transformation

The happiest month of the Jewish year is Adar, the month that includes Purim, Judaism's most joyous day. However, every few years, Adar doubles in size to



become a total of 60 days. This year the first Adar begins with two days of Rosh Hodesh on February 5 and 6.

According to the laws of kashrut, if a piece of non-kosher food falls into a pot of kosher food, and the amount in the pot is 60 times greater, then the undesirable food becomes nullified. It is as if the undesirable never existed. The Lubavitcher Rebbe taught that on a leap year like this year, all undesirable elements in our lives, like pain, sadness and discouragement become nullified. Such is the transformative power of double Adars, of joy.

Too often we allow a small hurt or unpleasant word against us to ruin our day. Unfortunately, there is rain and disappointment, insults and aggravation around us without fail. Let the message of the double Adars remind us that a minor setback or small issue should not be allowed to be magnified. There is an overwhelming amount of good out there and so many more blessings than curses that we encounter.

So if one in 60 can nullify traif food, it can do the same for the negativity we must deal with on a daily basis.

Remember, Adar is doubled this year and so is our joy. Feel good and grateful and optimistic during these two Adars. And let that spirit continue all year long.
