

This address is for the use of the entire Temple membership to request a particular honor for any service, any time, to read a Haftara, and for the submission of any comments.

Under the direction of Judy Koles, the Ritual Committee has inaugurated breakfast after the morning minyan. It is scheduled every Wednesday in Annex 1. Donations are requested to cover the cost of the food. Sponsorships will be available for a more elegant spread to honor a special occasion. If there is sufficient interest, the breakfast can be expanded to include additional days.

The Kitchen subcommittee has been formed under the chairmanship of Gayle Savitz and Hella Reitman. Plans have been prepared to reconfigure and upgrade the kitchen to ease the monitoring of the kashrut conditions. It will be mandatory that a member of the kitchen committee be in the kitchen whenever food is being prepared or served. These volunteers will be oriented in the workings of the kitchen and will observe the food servers at these times to assure the proper handling of the food, supplies and equipment.

Some of the future events being considered by this committee are a Golden Shabbat being conducted by congregants over the age of 90, a Tu B'shevat seder, musical presentation at the Friday evening service, instructions for Hagba and Glilla and Torah and haftara chanting. If you are interested in participating in any of these events, please contact the ritual committee. Keep your eyes and ears open for future developments.

Scholar ín Resídence Sheryl Roth

The January 25-27th, 2019 1st Annual Jack and Nancy Bushinsky Scholar in Residence weekend was well attended, educational and positively received by our congregation and community. We learned a great deal from Dr. Richard Freund, the Maurice Greenberg Professor of Jewish history and Director of the Center for Judaic Studies at the University of Hartford in Connecticut. He is a field archaeologist and historian who has developed a new method of working on sites with particular social, political and religious sensitivities. We found him to be an engaging and lively speaker. His Friday evening lecture during services was entitled "Did the Exodus really happen: Insights from archaeology". Saturday during services, he spoke about "The Messiah of Judaism: finding Bar Kohkba in a cave". Sunday was the UN date for commemoration of the Holocaust and he gave an A/V presentation about his Holocaust excavations.

Great news. The company that takes care of security systems in the Temple was here about two weeks ago and checked all of our systems: security, fire, lights, doors, etc. and determined that everything was in good working condition. You can take a deep sigh of relief! That takes care of what we already have. Now for what we are getting: On order are four emergency call buttons. They are the size of a small flashlight and work almost as fast as a flash of light. They send a signal to a 911 station and several Palm Beach Sheriff's cars, plus Fire/Rescue vehicles are immediately dispatched. The security guards will be in charge of those devices. In addition, we will be getting a set of what used to be called, "Walkie – Talkies", so one guard and/or Temple member can be in immediate touch with another. Another hardware item to be checked out is a proper whistle to use when signaling for an evacuation. There will be no charge for this item as I have donated several to the Temple!

The Security Committee is still working on evacuation plans to get everyone out of the Sanctuary or Social Hall as quickly and safely as possible. Yes, those using wheelchairs, walkers or canes are in the plan as Joan and Lester Schwartz are on the committee. Other Temples and Fire/Rescue units are being consulted. More is involved than saying, "Let's try this plan and see if it works," because anywhere from 100 to 500 members and guests attend our services and events. Yes, there will be practice evacuations.

To help manage all the items that are under consideration, Bill Schwartz has been appointed as my assistant. He and I are the liaisons with the District 4 Palm Beach Sheriff's Office, which is located two doors to the East of the Temple. The Captain in charge is a great leader, is on our side, and is pushing this teamwork approach. The Temple is part of an organization that links other Temples and Synagogues in the area with the PBSO. Again, this is instantaneous linkage through cell phones.

A few members have questioned whether all the security items, procedures and costs are necessary. The answer is YES. Physical items can be replaced; people cannot be. It had been said that good people were marching with the KKK and White Supremacists in Charlottesville last year. History indicates otherwise. We believe in being prepared.



Spotlight on Marvin & Margot Cohen

For Marvin and Margot, 1948 seems like yesterday. That's when they met at a party in Washington Heights in Upper Manhattan. "He was sweet and quiet," she recalls. "She was very pretty", he adds. Six months later they were married...and are still going strong 70 years later. Margot lived outside Stuttgart, Germany, until her family came to the U.S. when she was 10, just five months before Kristallnacht. "We knew what

was coming," she says, "and got out just in time. Much of our family was lost."

After finishing high school in Washington Heights, Margot studied bookkeeping and worked for a real estate management company, personally managed a 60-physician medical building and four tennis clubs. A Brooklyn native, Marvin graduated from Stuyvesant High School and served in the Army during World War II. He became a skilled typographer and was foreman of a printing company with 45 employees who typeset, formatted and proofread ads for major department stores.

"There was such a housing shortage after the war, you had to bribe building superintendents to get a chance at an apartment," Marvin laughs. They moved to Franklin Square, L.I. in 1950 and raised two sons, Jeff, who lives in Port St. Lucie, and Richard, of Oceanside, L.I. They have three grandchildren, Matthew, 16, and Deanna and Elizabeth, both 26.

Their lives in Franklin Square were full and busy. Marvin worked the night shift, often 12 hours straight. At Franklin Square Jewish Center, Marvin was President; Margot was Sisterhood President. They also found time to take their boys on family trips.

In 1996, they moved to Delray Beach and joined Temple Anshei Shalom at the urging of the late Paul Felder (TAS President Emeritus) whom they'd known for decades. Paul's wife Ruth was Margot's second cousin.

It didn't take long for both of the Cohens to get involved at TAS, Margot as coordinator for Sisterhood's "phone squad", and Marvin as Board member and coordinator of the synagogue's printed materials. In 2002, the Board created a new office specifically for him, Vice President for Communications, which he continues to hold.

Today, Marvin, 91, is still busy editing, proofing and formatting our weekly Shabbat programs, the annual Book of Remembrance and the Lifelong Learning Catalogue. He's also responsible for printing and mailing weekly Yahrzeit letters and overseeing installation of Yahrzeit plaques. But every afternoon and evening, he's at the side of his Margot, 90, who resides at a longterm care facility in Delray. They both love visitors! Please give them a head's up first by calling Marvin's cell, 561-573-4048.



Nabucco is considered to have permanently established Verdi's reputation as a composer. He commented that "this is the opera with which my artistic career really begins. And though I had many difficulties to fight against, it is certain that Nabucco was born under a lucky star".

Storyline: Follows the plight of the Jews as they are assaulted, conquered and subsequently exiled from their homeland by the Babylonian King Nabucco (in English, Nebuchadnezzar II). The historical events are used as background for a romantic and political plot. The best-known number from the opera is the "Chorus of the Hebrew Slaves" ("Fly, thought, on golden wings"), a chorus which is regularly given an encore in opera houses when performed today.
