#### Rabbí's Column Rabbí Raphael Adler

I write these words from the Golan town of Katzrin, having just visited a second century Jewish community with a synagogue mentioned in the Talmud that has been recently excavated, with a sensory overload that is richly welcomed.



The story of Israel is commemorated in the next few weeks and etched into the psyche of the Jewish People through Lag B'Omer, Israel's Independence Day and Jerusalem Day.

The first recalls the final failed revolt of Judea until The modern settlement or Yishuv Movement in the 19th and 20th Centuries.

The second commemorates the victorious creation of Israel in May of 1948.

And the final, marks the liberation of Jerusalem in June of 1967.

Visiting Israel, these dates are not history, but rather alive in the stones and air around you. When one is in Israel, you are home. When you meet Israelis, you are in the presence of flesh and blood heroes who choose to live, defend, and love this land as an act of courage, defying a world that makes this act dangerous and believes it to be wrong. When you watch children at play, you are witnessing the words of our ancient prophets come alive. Around every bend and over each hill is something unforgettable and amazing that truly feels magical.

During this past week I have met a father, an immigrant from Russia, who's daughter's life was shattered by the Rimon terrorist bombing in Jerusalem. I have stood next to a world famous Pediatric Heart Surgeon, a recent arrival from Belgium saving lives at Hadassah Hospital. I ate dinner with an IDF Reserve Colonel who created a program known as Shomer Hadash, that protects farmers on the borders against Bedouin looters, as a mitzvah of reaching out to our brothers and sisters. And I have responded Amen to the fervent prayers of pious women touching the wall that

The fashion show at the end of March was enjoyed by all.


In April there will be no general meeting because of Passover.

#### Computer-Savvy Grandchildren Solve 89-Year-Old Family Mystery Jan Schwartz



When Irving Friedman, 92, of Delray Beach, was co-honoree at a recent Israel Bonds breakfast at Temple Anshei Shalom, he was surrounded by 44 family members—including two half-brothers he didn't know existed a few months ago.

"I was the seventh of eight children, living in Manhattan and later in the Bronx," he recalls. "My father, Hyman Friedman, abandoned the family when I was three, vanishing without a trace. We never knew why and as the years passed, we thought we would never have the answer."

Irving's mother, Sophie, raised her children alone and saw each of them grow into successful adults. Irving became a school social worker and raised four daughters before retiring to Florida with his late wife Evelyn in 1996. His only surviving sibling, Jean, 102, lives in West Palm Beach.

Irving and Evelyn became active at Temple Anshei Shalom, Irving serving as President of both the Temple and its Men's Club. He is a current Board member and sings in the choir. He was content but never stopped being curious about the dad who had disappeared.

Then, six months ago in Rockland County, NY, Irving's granddaughter, Jenna, submitted a DNA sample on Ancestry.com. Soon after, her mother got a phone call from Avi Frier, of Hollywood, Florida, who had also signed on with Ancestry.com and found he was likely related to the Friedman family.

The pieces of the family puzzle began falling into place, including some startling coincidences. It was discovered that when Hyman Friedman left his first family, he moved to Baltimore, changed his name to Frier and started a second family. He had two more sons, Ralph and Lenny, who live in Baltimore. Avi Frier is Ralph's son and the grandson of Hyman Friedman/Frier.

Though neither knew it at the time, Irving and Avi had crossed paths three years earlier when Avi, a professional comedic magician, performed at one of our Anshei After Dark events.

Similarly, Irving's half-brother Lenny Frier is a snowbird, residing in the Coral Lakes community in Delray Beach during the winter months. When he's in Delray, he frequently attends Shabbat services—at Temple Anshei Shalom.

"It's stunning to think I might have been sitting next to my half-brother so many times without knowing it," Irving says. Today, the Friedmans and Friers are making up for lost time. Irving and Lenny now sit together on Shabbat. "Who expects to find two new brothers and a wonderful new extended family at my age?" Irving says. "Though we were strangers most of our lives, we are family now."

Irving's co-honoree at the Israel Bonds breakfast was our own Arthur H. Greenwald, recognized for his extensive, longtime efforts on behalf of Jewish War Veterans on the local, state and national levels.

#### A Bio on our Featured Speaker

Celie Lackner Heinish Halzel is a child survivor of the Holocaust. She was born in Radauitz, Rumania prior to the start of World War II. Celie grew up in her adopted home in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada. She attended college in Montreal where she earned a Master's



Degree in Hebrew Education. She taught Hebrew and Jewish studies for over 40 years in Canada, in an immigrant village near Jerusalem, and in several communities in the US.

By dedicating her life to touching the minds and hearts of young people through Jewish education, she hopes that she deserved to have been one of a small remnant of Holocaust survivors.

Celie has shared her story with many children's groups both Jewish and non-Jewish. She has also addressed many Hadassah groups in the area. as well as Magen David Adom, ORT and the College of Arts and Letters at FAU. In retirement she has enjoyed volunteering at Menorah House, Temple Anshei Shalom and serving as VP of Education for Orah Delray Hadassah.

Celie and her husband enjoy travelling especially to Israel where they met while spending their junior year of college studying in Jerusalem.
