## Rabbi's Column

### 4 Questions Plus One

The core of the Seder experience is the youngest asking the eldest the "Ma Nishtana" or Four Questions. This sing-song series of statements and observations unlocks the entire "Magid" or retelling portion of the Haggadah.



It also captures the sacred tradition of Passover Night as a conversation between the generations.

When the child concludes her 4 Questions, the leader begins the answers, which take up the rest of the evening, "Avadim Hayinu", we were slaves to Pharaoh.

That is the prevailing custom.

However, the Lubavitcher Rebbe received from his father-in-law, the previous Rebbe, a different tradition. Instead of the leader responding with the story of Passover, he should repeat the 4 Questions for himself and all the adults.

This follows the approach of Maimonides, that after teaching our children, we are commanded to study for ourselves.

The idea is that Jewish learning is not just for children, but every one, at every age, should reconnect with learning Torah.

And if you say, well I am already knowledgeable and hardly need to review the Ma Nishtana, the Rebbe himself modeled the message that self education is essential, even for a Rebbe.

Indeed, with Passover arriving, take the time to study a Haggadah with a good commentary, or connect with websites such as Haggadot.com, that is full of fascinating insights and lessons on Judaism's most magical evening of the year.

## Security

You have probably heard by now there is a new item in the arsenal of TAS security. It is commonly referred to as a panic button. Our security guards will have one when they are on duty. It is about 1½ inches in diameter and is worn on a lanyard around the neck. When the button is pressed, a signal is sent through the TAS security system to a computer that knows our name and location. Without a word being spoken, a sheriff's car will be in front of the building in about 20 seconds, followed by 2 or 3 other sheriff's cars, followed by a fire truck, followed by an emergency medical vehicle (EMT). That is a fast response time!

There are 30 different law enforcement agencies in Palm Beach County. The District 4 office of the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office is two doors to the east of us. The Captain there is going to have 6 to 8 deputy sheriffs go through our Temple as part of their training to become knowledgeable in what a Jewish House of Worship looks like inside, what the symbols are and what a Torah looks like. They will evaluate our security and make recommendations for improvement. After a little more training, they will then go through other temples, synagogues and chabads. My assistant, Bill Schwartz, and I will point out what they missed! We will then get a written report. The Temple has held two large events involving the PBSO and Homeland Security in November and December last year. Both had about 300 officers and congregants attend. Besides, Bill and I are good friends of the Captain.

Other security improvement projects are in progress and will be announced when they are completed. For your information: In 2017, 16.7 million identification thefts occurred. Florida was ranked number 2 in the nation. To report an identity theft, go to: [identitytheft.com](http://identitytheft.com). There are three credit reporting agencies that offer free credit reports each year. Space the reports out over the year. On the computer, the address is: [annualcreditreports.com](http://annualcreditreports.com). Also, be sure to lock your cars at night. Thieves are going around to various communities and going through unlocked cars.

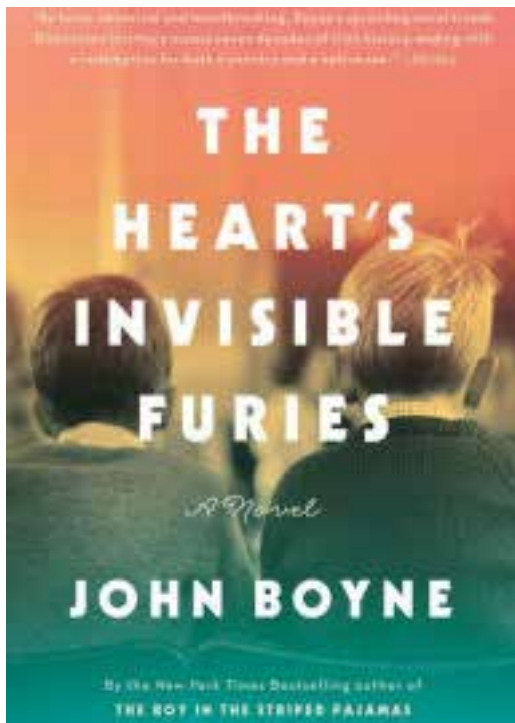

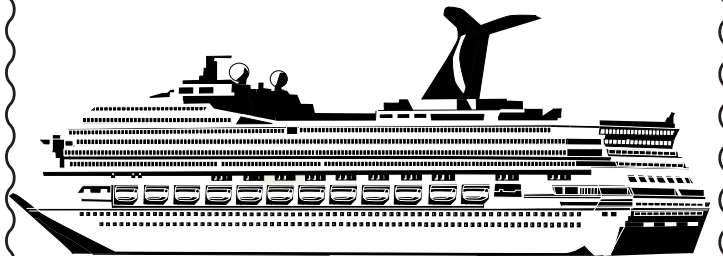

## **A Bio on our Featured Speaker**

Celie Lackner Heinisch Halzel is a child survivor of the Holocaust. She was born in Radautz, Rumania prior to the start of World War II. Celie grew up in her adopted home in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada. She attended college in Montreal where she earned a Master's Degree in Hebrew Education. She taught Hebrew and Jewish studies for over 40 years in Canada, in an immigrant village near Jerusalem, and in several communities in the US.



By dedicating her life to touching the minds and hearts of young people through Jewish education, she hopes that she deserved to have been one of a small remnant of Holocaust survivors.

Celie has shared her story with many children's groups both Jewish and non-Jewish. She has also addressed many Hadassah groups in the area, as well as Magen David Adom, ORT and the College of Arts and Letters at FAU. In retirement she has enjoyed volunteering at Menorah House, Temple Anshei Shalom and serving as VP of Education for Orah Delray Hadassah.

Celie and her husband enjoy travelling especially to Israel where they met while spending their junior year of college studying in Jerusalem.



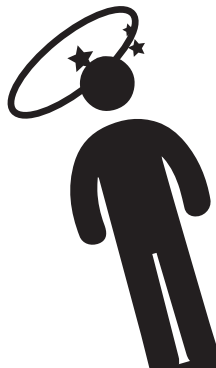
