Dedicate, Consecrate, Educate

Hanukah time is here again, and it arrives when we need it the most. It is the first recorded event in human history of a battle waged not for land or wealth, but fought for an idea. The idea was the belief that God should be worshipped as our conscience dictates it.



Then, and now, that message remains clear. Judaism is so precious that it is worth putting our very lives on the line. A small yet determined minority, even among the Jewish community adamantly refused to renounce their Jewish faith. Because of their heroism, we are here!

In this age of rampant world-wide Jew hatred, there are many of us who are tempted to curb public displays of our faith, and stop attending "dangerous" places like synagogues. Among our youth, standing up for Israel and identifying themselves as Zionists has become unpopular and subject to threats. Hanukah arrives to teach once again that the price of Judaism is high but well worth it.

When we feel overwhelmed and afraid, it is good to recall that the most powerful miracles of Hanukah are ones created by our ancestors through their grit, determination and force of conviction. Teaching Judaism and observing fundamental rituals such as Shabbat and Brit Milah put our People at severe risk to their lives. Yet, they resisted and many paid the ultimate price. Today, we may be scorned and insulted for our Yiddishkeit, but we fiercely continue undaunted and unashamed. We thrive and live our religion out loud and proud.

The Jewish festival that focuses on being different and unafraid is Hanukah. The entire purpose of these eight days is to stand up for what we believe in. The right to worship as we please, the hard-won battle for Jewish independence, and the heroism of putting our People and God first, regardless of the odds or danger, is enshrined annually in our candle lighting and public displays of our menorahs in the window.

We light these lights for the Maccabees, for the persecuted Jews throughout the ages, for the 6 Million, in solidarity with Israel and in tribute to the mass murder in Pittsburgh.

Sing, laugh, spin your dreidel and eat those latkes....It is good to be a Jew.

He will trace his wife's family from 1789 through the Holocaust to the present day and will show you the internet sites for researching your own family's genealogy. There are no dues or tickets required. The door is always open. Sunday through Friday at 8:30 am and 5:00 pm come in and daven with some of the nicest people you will ever meet.

4. 101-250 The TAS Spirit Award, special Kippah, name on plaque, invitation to participate in Minnyannaires Shabbat Service and an award given on the Bimah
5. 251+ The Minnyannaires' Leader Award Certificate, invitation to participate in Minnyannaires Shabbat Service, the Leader Award given on the Bimah, special Kippah and your name on plaque
6. Highest attendance Best Attendance
TAS Kippah, invitation to present a small speech about Minyan, brick on our tribute wall in the hallway with a certificate.

There will be 2 separate categories morning and afternoon!

Yahrzeit year does not count and Yahrzeit days do not count.

Those who attended regularly during a Yahrzeit year will be mentioned in a bulletin at a Yizkor Service. Shabbat and Holidays do not count. Must be TAS Member Being a Minnyannaire is your life line. You can always phone a friend to join you or ask a congregant to help you with the prayers. Let your final answer be yes! I want to be known as a Minnyannaire!
