Be A Moses

Seder time has its origins in one verse taken from the Book of Exodus that speaks to the heart of the feast of freedom. Just two words define the purpose of the most unique evening(s) of the year. "Vehegadeta lavincha", "You shall



tell your children". The key to the experience is the older generation relating the Passover story to the youth. Of all annual Jewish ritual events, Seder is by far the most cherished and widely observed. Because it strikes a chord very deep and profound in our collective Jewish souls.

Have you ever wondered who was the first Seder leader? Our rabbis inform us that since retelling the story was devised for children not present at the first Passover following liberation, that there were only two children absent from Egypt and the sea.

The two children were Gershom and Eliezer, Moses own sons, who were in Midian when the miracles occurred. So the first Seder leader was none other than their father, Moses. Therefore, when we open the Haggadah and share our journey from slavery to freedom, we are actually following in the footsteps of the greatest Jew who ever lived.

Since we are in the place of Moses, let us feel the excitement and make the Seder personal and alive, as if our own eyes, ears, and bodies actually were present so very long ago. Have the little ones imagine, in some way, what it was actually like to be a slave in Egypt, perhaps relate it to a feeling of abandonment when we lose sight of a parent. Associate the wonder of crossing the sea to being permitted to do an "adult" responsibility for the first time.

Treat the entire story with the kind of wonderment reserved for the most amazing spell-binding adventure, because it is! (continued on page 2

Since you and I are role-playing Moses, realize the tremendous opportunity we have to impart our beautiful Judaism to our future. Don't allow your Seder to be a lifeless, joyless, impersonal chore. High energy, personal vignettes, exuberance and connection should be the order of the evening. Remember WWMD — what would Moses do? You are he and a Jewish tomorrow is in your hands.

No gimmicks are needed or cutesy song parodies. Simply remember what brought you excitement and meaning as a child and channel those memories as best you can. The stakes are very high, but you are up to the challenge. I will be offering a workshop devoted to this on an upcoming Torah Tuesday class.

How many of you remember the song by the Serendipity Singers from 1964 titled, "Don't Let The Rain Come Down"?

That is exactly what happened on Monday, February 10th, when the rain came down into the Chapel. Luckily, Melissa, our Temple Administrator, saw what was happening, got David Zimmer, our Financial V.P. and Jo Anne, our bookkeeper, to get the large trash barrels to catch the rain that was falling into the Chapel. Fortunately, the roofers had been working on the Sanctuary roof that day. They helped us by putting up tarps and doing some temporary repairs. Thank you, Simon Roofing and the others.

After more than four months of negotiations, Palm Beach County has given Simon Roofing the green light to work on the roof. On Monday, February 10th, they began work on the roof over the Sanctuary and Chapel. They are working diligently to get these two sections of the roof completed by March 13th, at a cost of approximately \$165,000. The rest of the roof over the ballroom and annex will be done at a later date.

We have some structural damage to the building on the Atlantic Avenue side that must be addressed soon. We also have renovations of the kitchen, ballroom and lobby to do.

Now for the first time in 40 years we have a Capital Campaign. As you may know, our goal is to raise \$500,000. To date, we have raised \$385,000. A huge thank you to our generous members, snowbirds, guests and businesses who have already made donations. For those congregants and guests who have not yet contributed, we implore you to make a donation so that we can reach our goal to ensure the safety of our building as we continue to serve Delray Beach and the surrounding Conservative Jewish communities with our Shabbat services, holiday celebrations, classes and social programs.

When you are in the building, please take a form and an envelope from the table in the lobby and bring it to the office or mail it in so that YOU can be counted as one who has helped Temple Anshei Shalom reach its goal. Please mark your donation for the Capital Campaign. Your name will be included on our Wall of Recognition.

- 6. Highest attendance Best Attendance

TAS Kippah, invitation to present a small speech about Minyan, brick on our tribute wall in the hallway with a certificate.

There will be 2 separate categories morning and afternoon!

Yahrzeit year does not count and Yahrzeit days do not count.

Those who attended regularly during a Yahrzeit year will be mentioned in a bulletin at a Yizkor Service. Shabbat and Holidays do not count. Must be TAS member. Being a Minyanaire is your life line.
